(By the bottle)

18 CHATEAU REYNIER 2002, Bordeaux Superieur £14.95

This is a delicious House Claret that looks as classy as it tastes! The wine has plenty of fruit and balancing tannins that result in a wine of beauty and structure.

19 EL COTO CRIANZA 2001/2, Rioja £15.50
Half bottle £7.95

Full, rich, well structured benchmark Rioja from a celebrated Bodega. Made from Tempranillo and Garnacha this is a lovely supple style of wine with plenty of warmth and balancing grip.

20 COTES DU RHONE 2001, £16.95
Domaine Guigal

If you are after a smooth red wine with body and flavour, your search is over. The Rhone Valley offers very good value at the moment and Guigal make some of the most famous wines in the world.

21 FLEURIE 2004, Cuvée L'Ancienne £17.50

A delightful velvety texture balanced with ripe berries and a delicate touch of oak. Fleurie is always a popular choice and this will prove no exception.

22 STEP ROAD SHIRAZ 2002, Langhorne Creek £17.95

Lots of rich red fruits are found in this great example of classy Australian red. It is made in this very popular region in South Australia that is making a real name for itself with classic Shiraz.

ROSÉ WINE

23 TORRES CABERNET SAUVIGNON ROSÉ
Santa Digna 2004 £14.50

New World Rosé appears to be taking off a bit and this example from Chile exhibits blackcurrant and raspberry flavours.

SPARKLING WINE

24 CURRABRIDGE BRUT NV,
South East Australia £14.95

A well known style that has more flavour than the majority of Sparklers!

CHAMPAGNE

25 GALLIMARD CUVÉE RESERVE NV BRUT £23.50

This is our House Champagne that has proved outstandingly popular.

26 VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL
NV BRUT £39.50

HOUSE WINES - WHITE

- 1 LOUIS ALEXANDRE DRY, Paul Boutinot**
A well made wine that is refreshingly dry and slips down barely touching the sides.
Bottle: **£9.50** 250ml Glass: **£3.60** 175ml Glass: **£2.50**
- 2 LOUIS ALEXANDRE MEDIUM, Paul Boutinot**
The winemakers must concentrate far more when making a medium wine and this illustrates what good value they can be!

- 3 LA REVERENCE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2004, Pays d'Oc**
A lovely fresh, crisp white wine from the South of France. Great value Sauvignon.

- 4 BORGIO SILENE BIANCO 2004, Sicilia**
This is a dry, crisp white wine from the Island where you do not really mess with anyone!!

- 5 MOSCATO D'ASTI 2004, Alasia (Sweet)**
Always a tricky job getting a sweet wine at this level but Italy has provided the answer. This wine has a slight petillance or fizz if you prefer but has lovely fruit and charming sweetness.

- 6 SANDFORD SEMILLON/CHARDONNAY 2002, Victoria (Aus)**
A blend that has proved very popular and, along with the red, is responsible for making the Aussie wine business such a success.

- 7 VENTISQUERO CLASICO CHARDONNAY 2004, Colchagua Valley (Chile)**
Chile is producing some wonderful wines at the moment and is offering real value. This is a soft easy Chardonnay with citrus fruits and a touch of cream.

HOUSE WINES - RED

- 8 PASQUIERS SHIRAZ/VIOGNIER 2003, Vin de Pays de Vaucluse**
The Viognier gives the Shiraz a burst of lifted freshness that makes the wine a lovely easy drink with a touch of spice.

- 9 LA REVERENCE SYRAH 2004, Vin de Pays d'Oc**
This is a fresh, big style of wine reminiscent of the Rhone Valley. The wine has balance and weight and a finish of chocolate and spice. This has been hugely popular and will please any palate.

- 10 LES VIGNEAUX MERLOT 2004, Vin de Pays d'Oc**
For those looking for a lighter, smooth style of red, this is the one. It is a juicy wine with plum and chocolate on the palate and a long balanced finish.

- 11 SANDFORD SHIRAZ/CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2003, South East Australia**
This is a full flavoured ripe wine with blackcurrant and warming spice and finishes with strength and length.

- 12 VENTISQUERO CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2004 Colchagua Valley (Chile)**
A charming ruby red wine that has berries and plum aromas and a soft silky finish that oozes class. Chile at its mercurial best.

- 13 PIESPORTER MICHELSBERG 2003, Schmitt Sohne £10.50**
A refreshing, clean medium dry wine with a delicate balance between sweetness and acidity.
- 14 PINOT GRIGIO 2004, Terre del Noce Dolomites £12.95**
Excellent fresh, clean, dry white wine with good fruit and a lasting, refreshing finish.
- 15 MILLS REEF SAUVIGNON BLANC 2004, Hawkes Bay £15.95**
A New Zealand wine from this region in the North Island. The wine is packed with passion fruit and lime flavours. It is an easy drinking style with a crisp, fresh finish.
- 16 STEP ROAD CHARDONNAY 2004, Adelaide Hills £16.50**
This region of South Australia is blessed with a cool climate that is ideal for leaving some finesse within the wines. This is a beauty!!
- 17 CHABLIS 2004, Domaine du Colombier, Guy Mothe £19.50**
This chap believes in minimal intervention with his wine and still handpicks his grapes exercising rigorous selection. The wine exhibits classic mineral steeliness and no oak.
